
TAKING STRATEGIC ACTION

Actions taken by district partners based on learning from the Listening and Learning Assessment include:

- Confirm to school board alignment between strategic priorities, change effort implementation and impact on student experience
- Improved student feedback systems through regular surveys and focused interviews with specific student groups
- Commitment to addressing incidents of harm, decreasing the use of derogatory terms and increased use of restorative practices
- Engage stakeholders in creation of multi-year Strategic Plan informed by Listening Assessment
- Improved systems of two way communication with parents and families act as accountbility toward strategic measures
